

Summer School of the DLGS

Since 2006, the **DLGS Summer School** has been established as a central activity of the doctoral program of the Dresden Leibniz Graduate School. It provides an ideal platform to present and discuss theory, methodology, research design and results in social sciences, while also sharpening communication and presentation skills. It is worth pointing out that DLGS candidates are coming from different disciplines, therefore the summer school calls for stressing the value of an interdisciplinary approach bringing together knowledge from diverse perspectives to understand current issues of change.

Motivation

In order to ensure consistency across the doctoral process - from project proposal to publish results - the 2010 edition of the **DLGS Summer School** is oriented to discuss and analyze research proposals and outcomes. On the one hand, doctoral candidates of the second cohort will discuss how to build and raise their research profiles through undertaking a range of activities that can provide useful skills and experience and enable them to explore possible career paths. On the other hand, doctoral candidates of the first cohort will focus on the discussion of strategies for transferring and disseminating research findings to policy makers and society.

Aims

The **DLGS Summer School** is aimed at providing DLGS doctoral candidates with an opportunity to present their research, to discuss new developments in their fields and establish contacts with experts in their field of research.

The fifth Summer School is aimed to give doctoral candidates an opportunity to benefit from knowledge transference through an international dialogue, so as to share different frameworks to understand current challenges in times of economic, demographic, and climate changes.

One of the main endeavours of the **DLGS Summer School** is to develop research skills by offering lectures and exercises on strategies to raise research profile and on disseminating research results.
